I. Strong Workforce Regional Project

- Funds allocated to CCC to strengthen CTE. Given 14 million to LA Region. Originally, 40% regional project, things where we work together, expand what we have with LAH3C. National Model Foundational Curriculum, LAHSRP (Los Angeles Health Science Regional Project)
- Stronger and Better CTE
- 3 tiers:
- Developing specialty RN program (Rio Hondo Lead)
- Build Radiology Tech, Respiratory Therapy program (Santa Monica)
- CCC – Rollout and LAH3C –\$320,000 at least \$250K *Health Sector*?
- Funds to be spent before Dec 2018
- Money will be used to share project HOC and Digital badges to strengthening Health Science, events for dissemination of LAH3C curriculum
